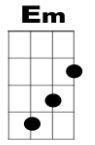
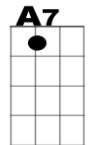


Tiptoe Thru the Tulips (Al Dubin & Joe Burke, 1929)

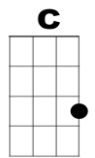
