

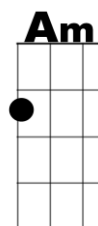
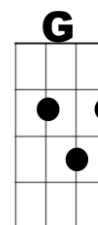
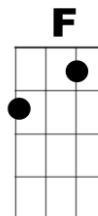
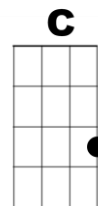
# Blowin' In the Wind
