**E7**

**D**

**G7**

Won't you guide my sleigh tonight?”

**C**

Then all the reindeer loved him

And they shouted out with glee,

*Repeat both verses, 2<sup>nd</sup> time through repeat last line of Verse 2 getting slower led by the bells:*
