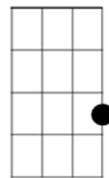

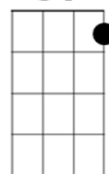

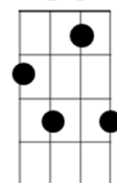

# Blue Suede Shoes (Carl Perkins 1955, Elvis Presley 1956 & 1960)

## Notes on the chord change from G7 to F7 in the Chorus

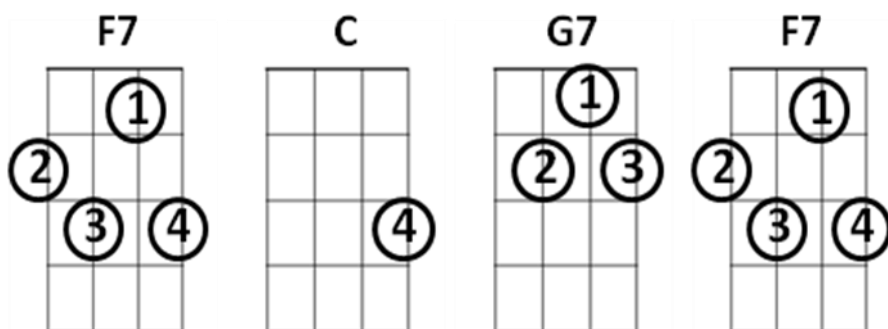
### First the numbering of strings.

Note the 1<sup>st</sup> string is tuned to the highest note A and when you are playing is physically at the bottom of the Uke's neck.

String number → **4 3 2 1**  
**G C E A** ← Tuned to



**F7, C and G7 fingering** (where 1 = first or index finger etc):



### The change from G7 to F7:

Move 2<sup>nd</sup> finger from 2<sup>nd</sup> fret of 3<sup>rd</sup> string to 2<sup>nd</sup> fret of 4<sup>th</sup> string, which makes F chord

Move 3<sup>rd</sup> finger from 2<sup>nd</sup> fret of 1<sup>st</sup> string to 3<sup>rd</sup> of fret 3<sup>rd</sup> string & place 4<sup>th</sup> finger on 3<sup>rd</sup> fret of 1st string, which makes F7 chord
