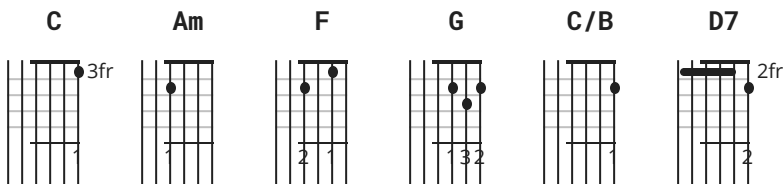


# Lou Mystic Usher - Sea Of Heartbreak ukulele chords by Misc Unsigned Bands
