*Fast: Speed 192 bpm*

**C**  
Pack up your troubles in your old kit-bag  
**Am F C**  
And smile, smile, smile,  
**C E7 Am**  
While you've a Lucifer to light your fag,  
**D7 G7**  
Smile, boys, that's the style,  
**C G7**  
What's the use of worrying,  
**F G7 G7/**  
It never was worth-while, so  
**C F**  
Pack up your troubles in your old kit-bag  
**C G7 C C/**  
And smile, smile, smile.
